





Systems of Oppression



Top 5 Facts

Cannabis:

1. Still federally **illegal**. In CA, it is 56% illegal
2. Prop 215 "Patients" | Prop 64 "**Consumers**" 90%
3. Taxes **33.5%** Local (10%) Excise (15%) Sales (8.5%)
4. **Propaganda** is alive. We are NOT immune
5. **They made it political first** War on Drugs June 1971


